IFB SU-010117 – Painting Services

Questions and Answers

Question 1: Once awarded, is the painting work continuous?

Answer 1: -depends on our needs and the academic year. It may be continuous during summer months, but then slowing down in fall.

Question 2: Is a painting crew required every day?

Answer 2: –depends on our needs

Question 3: Is the work to be performed during business hours, or are weekends and evenings required?

Answer 3: The normal workweek shall be Monday through Friday 8:00AM to 5:00PM. Contractor may be permitted to work earlier or later hours if approved in advance by the College. Contractor will be required to submit such requests in written format to the Project Manager at least 72 hours in advance. College will make every reasonable effort to accommodate such requests.

Question 4: Will one room or one area at time be available for painting, or several, simultaneously?

Answer 4: – depends on the area and the job. Could be a single room, could be an entire floor.

Question 5: Will the rooms to be painted be emptied prior to commencement?

Answer 5: – not always. Some jobs will require the painter to move items, while others will require items to be covered/tarped.

Question 6: Aside from the floor, are there any fixtures that we will be required to protect in order to paint the spaces?

Answer 6: – yes. Sprinkler heads, fire alarm strobes, pull stations, etc., must be protected.

Question 7: Do PLA apply to this project?

Answer 7: No. This contract does not include Project Labor Agreement (PLA).

Question 8: Do Union wages & benefits apply to this project?

Answer 8: No.

Question 9: Is this job Open Shop?

Answer: Union affiliation is not a consideration in bid award. Prevailing Wage laws do apply to this contract.

Question 10: Does this job require bonding?

Answer: No.

Question 11: Is this job prevailing wage?

Answer 11: – Yes.
