

What does it cost to be seen in Student Health Services?

There is no charge to be seen in student health services. Office visits are FREE regardless of health insurance coverage. However, there are some things we do that may incur a fee. Below is a list of our fees:

- Administer injection: \$10.00
- Administer multiple injections: \$25.00 per semester
- Blood glucose testing: \$15.00
- Ear syringing (cleaning ear wax): \$25.00
- Flu shot: \$20.00
- Hemocult x 3: \$15.00
- Hemoglobin testing: \$15.00
- HIV test (rapid): \$20.00
- HPV removal: \$25.00
- Incision and drainage: \$35.00
- Inhalation Nebulizer (for asthma): \$20.00
- IPPD (Tuberculosis screening skin test): \$15.00
- Molluscum removal: \$30.00
- Mono test (rapid): \$15.00
- Office visit (CE students only): \$25.00
- Physical exam (Entrance requirement): \$125.00
- Pregnancy test (urine): \$15.00
- Strep test (rapid): \$15.00
- Suture removal: \$25.00
- Urinalysis: \$ 10.00

In addition, there are fees related to most medications and supplies that are dispensed. These prices vary.

Please ask your health care provider if you are not sure whether your visit will result in a fee.
