EXPRESS Check-Out Details

All residents are required to use the EXPRESS check-out system.

Here is what you'll need to do!

- 1. Pick up an EXPRESS check-out envelope from your RC's office.
- 2. Pack all your belongings, CLEAN the room and remove ALL personal items. The room MUST be empty (of your belongings) before you check-out.
- 3. Fill out the express check out envelope.
- 4. LOCK your door and place your key(s) inside the envelope.
- 5. Seal the envelope.
- 6. Tear the yellow copy for your record (save just in case).
- 7. Return the EXPRESS check-out envelope to the office with a staff member. After hours, the envelopes can be dropped in the mail slot outside your RC's office.

DO NOT leave the completed envelope in your room or with your roommates!!!!

SAMPLE Damage Billing Charges

Lost Keys*

Single room = \$90 Double/Triple room = \$90

Two bedroom suite = \$155

Three bedroom suite = \$205

Four bedroom suite = \$270

*Does not include exterior key

Blinds/Screens

Replace blinds (sm) = \$50 Replace blinds (lg) = \$80 Replace screen (sm) = \$50 Replace screen (lg) = \$100

Furniture

Remove non-SUNY furniture (sm) = \$50 Remove non-SUNY furniture (lg) = \$100 Replace wood desk chair = \$230 Replace dresser = \$375 Replace mattress = \$150

Cleaning

Bathroom = \$50 Bedroom = \$50 per occupant Trash Removal = \$25 per bag Smoke – Bedroom = \$200 Non-Registered Pet – Bedroom = \$200

Housing for Fall 2018

While we certainly hope you will remain in on-campus housing, we want to remind you of important dates in the event your plans have changed.

- IF YOU PAID A DEPOSIT AND SELECTED HOUSING FOR FALL
 2018 if you will NOT be returning to on-campus housing for ANY reason for the fall semester, please email CEG@purchase.edu.
- Returning campus residents must be <u>enrolled for 8 or more credits for the</u> <u>Fall 2018 semester by June 8, 2018.</u> Campus residents who are not registered for classes, with 8 or more credits, by this date will lose their fall/spring housing assignment and will be refunded their housing deposit.
 As a reminder, you must be enrolled as a full-time student (12 or more credits) by the start

of the semester to maintain your eligibility to live on campus.

Housing Cancellation and Deadline Reminders

Housing Cancellation and Deadlines:

If you are no longer interested in living on campus during the 2018-2019 academic year, please contact our office immediately. As a reminder, the date to withdraw from campus housing without any financial liability is prior to **May I**, **2018.** A withdrawal up to the quarter point of the semester (September 20, 2018) allows a 50% recalculation based on your housing cost and commitment. After September 20, 2018, you are fully responsible for all of the housing charges. *Housing cancellations after May 1, 2018 result in a forfeiture of the housing deposit.*
