I. INTRODUCTION

The Purchase College, SUNY, Career Development Center (CDC) conducted the 14TH annual *Life after Purchase Graduate Survey: First Destination Survey* for the **Class of 2017**, with data collection beginning 6-8 months after commencement. This annual report was implemented in accordance with national standards and protocol for college “*First Destination Graduate Surveys*,” consistent with reporting career outcome (National Association of Colleges and Employers, 2017).

Although 6-8 months following graduation is the suggested standard time to initiate the full survey, industry recruiting practices and employment timelines generally vary between institutions and can have a significant impact on the overall reported outcome. Our findings will show that the current career fields, industries, and specific jobs/occupational fields where Purchase graduates initially locate employment do indeed vary. The overall positive career outcome may tend to be even stronger regarding graduate employment outcome, when the survey is launched 8 months to a year after graduation. Survey data is gathered to determine our graduate’s career outcome, focusing more specifically on Employment Status, Graduate/Professional School Enrollment, and Career Development Center usage.

II. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This 14TH annual *Life after Purchase Graduate Survey* for the **Class of 2017** details the post-graduate employment and graduate school enrollment supporting this graduating class’s positive career outcome. The graduates of 2017 encompass those who graduated summer 2016, winter 2017 and May 2017). *Purchase College graduate employment and graduate school enrollment outcome remains positive.*

- **87.8%** of graduates were found to be employed, in graduate school, or both at the time of the survey.
- Of those employed, **84.1%** are employed full or in a part-time capacity including self-employment, performing or freelancing in the arts. **41.4%** are employed full time, **33.1%** part time, and **9.7%** are employed with an unknown classification.
- **13.3%** are enrolled in graduate or professional school, with **7.8%** both employed and in graduate school.
- **61.3% (222)** of the respondents reported that their employment was either **related or somewhat related** to their field of academic study
- **44%** of the graduates found employment before graduation. **12%** were offered employment following a successful internship.
- *45.5% of these graduates were also found to be employed in a field relevant to their major.*
- **38.3%** of the graduates had at least one internship while at Purchase. **69.6% interned** for credit **12.5%** for pay only and **10.7%** for both credit and pay.
- **41.3%** of graduates from the School of Arts, **40.5%** from LAS, and **23.2%** from LSCE completed at least one internship while at Purchase.
- **67.5%** of the respondents reported that *as a result of their academic program, they are better prepared for their careers.*
- *76.5% of those who agree that their academic program prepared them for their careers, also used the Career Development Center.*
- **93.7%** of respondents rate the quality of the Career Center as excellent, very helpful or somewhat helpful. *67.6% report that the CDC exceeded or met their expectations.*
- **25.5%** of those employed found their position through services or resource available at Career Development.
- **77.8%** of Graduates had a full time or part time job while at Purchase.
- Our graduates are employed in many industries, however, the top 5 are **Arts, Business, Human/Social Services, Education, and Science & Technology.**


III. METHODOLOGY AND KNOWLEDGE RATE

Career outcome data was secured from **605** out of **1024** graduates within the **Class of 2017**. This included summer, winter, and spring graduates. In accordance with the national graduate survey protocol and guidelines by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) for *First Destination Surveys*, the CDC initiated data collection utilizing a more widely accepted range of graduate data research methods to strengthen our ability to provide a more complete picture of post graduate employment. Career outcome data secured represents an overall knowledge rate* of **59%**. Outcome data is collected through multiple methods for data collection including phone survey interviews, mail surveys, email, social media sourcing, faculty outreach email, employer and parental reporting, when appropriate.

(*Knowledge Rate: Describes the percentages of graduates for which the institution has reasonable and verifiable information concerning the grads post graduate career activities.)

Missing Values

Throughout the data analysis, all questions that were not answered by respondents or “missing values” were omitted and not included in the calculations. *As a result, the number of responses varies depending on the question asked.*







IV. CAREER OUTCOME HIGHLIGHTS



a. Employment Status

At the time of the survey, **87.8%** of Purchase graduates reported positive employment outcome including working full-time or part-time (including those self-employed, performing, creative arts freelancing, serving in the military, gap year service, and working and/or are enrolled in graduate school.) **84.1%** of the respondents from the Class of 2017 were found to be working at the time of the survey, with **41.4%** full time, **33.1%** part time, and **9.7%** of graduates are employed in some capacity though the classification is unknown. Part time employment includes **44%** from the SOA. Of those SOA grads reportedly self-employed part time, **42%** also reported to have a secondary job to help support themselves while

launching their careers. **5.0%** were self-employed full time (decrease), and **4.6%** were self-employed part-time. Of the grads who reported to be self-employed full time, **76.7%** are from the School of the Arts while **13.3%** are from LAS.




b. Employment & Grad School Status




c. Employment Fields & Relationship to Academic Studies

Purchase grads will locate post-graduate employment, whenever possible, in their field of interest and where opportunities fit with their competencies and other qualifications.


The career outcome for our graduates this year suggests that **61.4%** found employment that is either *directly or somewhat related* to their studies or area of interest.






38.7% of the respondents overall reported that their employment was **unrelated** to their field of academic study, the large majority including students from liberal arts. Of those not currently working in related fields, **48.1%** of these respondents reportedly are seeking employment related to their field of academic study. The graph below illustrates **52.4%** of LAS students who are employed in unrelated fields reported seeking work in their area of interest. Liberal arts graduates commonly consider their positions as “related” or somewhat related from a broad range of industries and across disciplinary areas and fields.

V. CAREER CHOICES: Majors in Relation to Employment




a. Academic Program Preparation and Careers

1. A robust **67.5%** of the respondents reported that *as a result of their academic program, they felt better prepared for their careers*. **32.5%** overall, strongly agree with this statement and **35.0%** agree.
 - **70.6%** of Arts graduates either strongly agree or agree
 - **62.8%** of LAS graduates strongly agree or agree
 - **71.7%** of LSCE students either strongly agree or agree that they were prepared for their careers.




2. Of further interest, data suggests that **76.5%** of the respondents who agreed that their academic programs prepared them for their careers also used the Career Development Center at *least one or more times*, once again verifying the importance of the career center's connection between a student's academic foundation and career/employment preparation.




b. Career Fields & Industries: Where Grads are Employed




The industries where graduates most commonly located their first jobs are grouped below.



An increase occurred for Purchase graduates finding work directly in the arts than in previous years, with **27.9%** working in **Arts** and/or related fields. This is followed by **Business** industries where the market can offer entry level openings with **24.2%** grads finding work (sales, marketing, hospitality, social media, event planning) **Education** is the next most common industry where students are finding jobs, **11.9%**. **Human Services** next with **14%** graduates employed. **Media & Communications** follows at **5.8%**. Although still narrowly defined, other fields where grads found work are **Healthcare** **4.8%**, **Public Service/Law** **4.2%**, and **Science/Tech/Environmental** **6.5%**.





Purchase Graduates reported their employment across a variety of industries and are working in a range of occupational titles within these broad career and industry areas. The graph below represents the broad industries where they are employed and the type of job/occupation is analyzed and condensed into career fields organized by school or conservatory.





c. Salaries

Those reporting an actual salary who are performing, freelancing or working in a part time or consultancy capacity are not counted in the FTE salary averages. **35.5%** of graduates reported their actual full time salary, with industries included and averaged. The *mean* or *average* salary for those reporting by major this year falls below the national average for full-time employment, at **\$34,366.72** with the national average for liberal arts majors is **\$39,172 (NACE 2017 Salary Survey)**. Salary levels may vary significantly year to year with various range fluctuations reported for certain industries and entry level positions. The average reported salary by graduates in the School of the Arts at Purchase was **\$31,538** while the national average for visual and performing arts is **\$37,006**.



- i. **Average Salary by Gender:** This year, those identifying as female reported an average salary *over* those identifying as male, however slight, this demonstrates positive movement. While salary varies by industry and occupational title, reported pay inequity is apparent among genders. Salary variation by gender can be illustrated in the career choices for those reporting genders and career field or industry. This year, there does *not* appear to be a clear link to the salary inequity with occupational industry nor does it appear a result of higher compensation expected per specific job titles. **59%** of the male respondents reported their annual salaries, and **55.8%** of the female respondents reported their annual salaries. The Career Development Center will continue to address this important issue by offering pay inequity training sessions to students and will provide resources on salary equity in discussions with prospective employers.





VI. LOCATING EMPLOYMENT: How & Where Purchase Graduates Find Jobs


The Career Development Center engages with students in career development and readiness programs/services to prepare them for future employment and career. Through individual and group career coaching, job and internship referral, networking with professionals and alumni, and other extensive resources, students learn the value of personal self-marketing, along with skill and interest development. Students tend to report whether they feel “prepared” for the job market, particularly if they both utilized the available services and tools or received other help with personal self-promotion and marketing, which is often a key to landing a first job.

While graduates seek and have found employment opportunities both here and abroad, a majority find their job opportunities generally in the NY metropolitan area, with **92.8%** of graduates reporting their region of employment as within NYS.



a. Finding Jobs: Career Development Center Usage



44% of the Class of 2017 reported they already had a job offer by graduation. **33.3%**, attribute their employment search strategy as one available or recommended through the Career Development programs and services as helping them secure employment, either directly or indirectly, an increase of **4.7%**. Students also secured their jobs through the use of online job search systems, **17.2%**. Our graduates use social media regularly as an important job-search tool. According to NACE's 2017 Student Survey, **68.8%** of graduating seniors are reporting to use it for networking and job search.




Those grads reporting getting their job as a result of their internship was 4.5% though 12% of the employers also serving as internship sites, reported making employment offers to their interns.

b. Applied Learning: Internship Participation

Internships and other types of experiential/applied learning, play an important role in Purchase College student career readiness and job market preparation. According to the national research, graduates who interned at one or more organizations are more likely to develop job related skills and qualities that can better prepare them for employment. (2017 NACE Internship & Co-op Survey). Those who reported having at least one or more internships while at Purchase were also found to be employed at higher rates after graduation (**89.2%**), once again supporting the validity of one's internship experience and other applied learning for strengthening a graduates prospects for employment. A positive outcome of internships though not assured, may be an offer of employment. Purchase interns were offered employment by **12%** of the internship site employers, following their internship experience.





Reported outcome for the graduates as *most active internship participation* were from respondents from Graphic Design **68.8%**, Environmental Studies **66.7%**, AMG **61%**, New Media **56%**, Sociology **50%**. Other notable participation from Math/Com Science **53.8%**, Literature **50%**, Media Studies **50%**, Journalism **41%**, Studio Production **36.4%**, Theater and Performance **36%**, Psychology **25%**.




VII. GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL ENROLLMENT

1. **13.3% (60)** of all respondents were enrolled in graduate or professional school at the time of the survey. Of those enrolled, **85%** are enrolled full-time and **13.3%** are enrolled part-time.
2. For all enrolled graduate students, **27.1%** are *also working full-time*, and **42.4%** are *also working part-time*, suggesting the need for grads to secure work or continue work while in graduate school to support their expenses.
 - This year, however, a higher rate of **27.1%** (20% increase) of those in graduate school are *not* working while in school.
 - **26%** are planning to enroll in 2-5 years. Of those not enrolled **53%** are not planning to enroll.




VIII. GRADUATE PROGRAMS AND ACADEMIC DISCIPLINES

Art Performance remains the 1st choice for field of study for graduate education at **26.7%** with graduate study in **Psychology** next at **11.7%**. **Education and Business** were tied for 3rd choice for graduate school, both with **10%** enrolled in these programs.



Graduate Degrees Being Pursued




IX. CAREER DEVELOPMENT: GRADUATES' USAGE AND PARTICIPATION

- ❖ 77.3% of the 2017 graduate respondents participated in one or more CDC services and programs, with the student engagement at the Purchase Career Development Center slightly above national average the same graduates standing at 72%
- ❖ 93.7% respondents rated the quality of the services used a CDC as *excellent, very helpful, or somewhat helpful* an increase of 4.5%
- ❖ 67.6% of those who used the services reported that the CDC met or exceeded expectations.
- ❖ The services most often used were **Purchase Job Score** system with 75% of the respondents using the system one or more times, 50.7% participating in **resume and personal statement critiques**, and 43.1% participated in **career counseling/coaching appointments**. Additional services used extensively with students include academic internships, job and grad school fairs, alumni networking events and workshops.

a. Employment & Career Development Center Usage:

Of the graduates who are employed full-time, 76 % used at least one or more Career Development services. Of the graduates employed part-time, 76.1% used at least one or more Career Development service. Our findings suggest that for those using at least one or more Career service or resource that their self-marketing skills, career readiness and ultimately their job search efforts are sharpened; with the majority using more likely to lead to employment.

X. SUMMARY & HIGHLIGHTS

University Career Centers nationwide continue to make an important impact on the career readiness and career outcome of college students. The career outcome reported in the *Life after Purchase: First Destination Survey* provides further evidence to support the excellence of our graduates both as students and now successful alumni.

This “Proof of Purchase” and *quality* of our students is demonstrated in many forms—with the majority (@88%) reporting positive career outcome that included employment, graduate school enrollment, post graduate internships, or participation in service. Our graduates are also pursuing, and succeeding in gaining entry into a competitive job market, while also enrolled in graduate programs, as well as building upon their artistic careers and entrepreneurial ventures.

As we continue to develop and fortify strong collaborations and partnerships across campus, the Career Center will also work to expand opportunities for our students so that they may graduate with career related experience and develop important competencies as they prepare for their future careers.

Highlights:

- **87.8%** of the graduates this year were either employed or enrolled in graduate or professional school at the time the survey was conducted. (slight dip due to shorter research timeline)
- Graduate and professional school enrollment occurred with **13.3%** enrolled in graduate and professional programs following this first year of graduation
- Our graduates are employed across 30 industries, with industry consolidation canvassing 5 key employment fields ***Arts, Business, Education, Human Services, Media & Communications, and Science/ Tech & Environment.***
- **Arts Performance** is the most popular graduate program for 2017 alumni, followed by **Psychology, Education, and Business** as close alternate fields of choice for graduate education. **6%** are currently enrolled in law school.

The Career Development Center continues its mission to engage students and alumni with inclusive career educational programming and customized career resources/services/tools that can both complement their education and assist in building important skills for personal and professional “career readiness”. As in previous years, the *Life after Purchase* report offers insight on graduate outcome that supports our mission. The Purchase College students, who are highly engaged both in and outside the classroom as well as those linked to academic/career relevant programs and services throughout their college years, are found to be better prepared and are more likely successful in securing employment and other post-graduate professional endeavors.
