SCENE ONE

Evening, Bastille Day, July 14, 2010 Place: Apartment/Condo in Miami, Florida

Tasteful dark furniture and pastel colored draperies surround 30 year old NATASHA LECOIN as she moves around a loft-like apartment. She's wearing a tight fitting black sheath dress. She walks back and forth between the living room--where a television is on and broadcasting a soccer game--to the dining room-- where she is setting up a table for 4--to the outside terrace-where she drapes a sheet over a massive easel. Inside the apartment, paintings hang on every wall. Ranging from small to large, from "naïf" to abstract, all of them depict or suggest sunrises, sunsets and birds. Natasha straightens out a few of them as she walks by. Some masterful, some mediocre, some plain awful, they are all her creation. Following her are SPIRIT CHILD 1, a 9 year old boy, SPIRIT CHILD 2, a 7 year old boy, and SPIRIT CHILD 3, a 1 year old girl. The Spirit Children can be symbolically played by adults or teenagers, but with clothes and behavior cues that suggest they are children. They may be dressed all in one color-purple or white--or in different bright colors that suggest they might have just leaped out of a painting. The Spirit Children move about the apartment unnoticed by Natasha and sometimes pause to look at the paintings and other objects lying around.

In the kitchen, Natasha continues cooking. Occasionally she stops to check her hair, teeth, and make up in the appliances.
