President's Award for Distinguished Alumni

Adotei Akwei '84

Adotei Akwei, whereas, you received a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and Economics as a member of the class of 1984,

Whereas, you were born in Ghana where your father worked as a diplomat in the Foreign Service for the West African country, then his diplomatic service brought your family to China and to the United Nations in New York as well. During his service in New York, your family lived in both New Rochelle and Mamaroneck in Westchester County,

Whereas, in 1980 you followed your older sister to Purchase College, who preceded you by one year, to study economics at your father's request,

Whereas, your interest in economics waned with exposure to classes in international relations, African literature, and political science. Your professors, including Connie Lobur, John Gitlitz, and Jean Herskovitz, were all influential and demanding and the discourse was inspiring, but one professor significantly impacted your life's work,

Whereas, the influence of your faculty advisor, Professor Peter Schwab, had a major role in the development of your intellect and career path. In his class you were exposed to the 1974 Vietnam War award-winning documentary film, *Hearts and Minds*, which inspired you to dedicate yourself to fighting abuse,

Whereas, following Purchase you attended William and Mary College, earning a Master of Arts in Government and International Relations. From there you began your 30-plus year career in advocacy work,

Whereas, in every role you've held, you have been a strong proponent for human rights,

Whereas, you worked for CARE USA in Bangkok and Washington DC and for more than 10 years at Amnesty International USA, the largest grass roots human rights organization in the world, as the senior advocacy director for Africa, as the director of campaigns, and most recently as the deputy director for advocacy and government relations,

Whereas, you testified before Congress and participated in human rights missions to Nigeria, Benin, and Ethiopia, and pursued advocacy work in Zimbabwe and Malawi as well,

Whereas, in 2000 you received the Washington Peacemaker Award from American University for work promoting human rights values to university students; and in 2003 you earned fellowships at the National Endowment for Democracy and the Carr Center for Human Rights Policy at Harvard University,

Whereas, your advocacy work included developing and implementing campaigns that address issues affecting Africa and Asia such as poverty, child soldiers in Africa, the conflict diamonds trade, HIV/AIDS, climate change, and the empowerment of women to name just a few,

Whereas, in 2017 you returned to Purchase College and delivered the Mary Edwards Lecture: "Breaking the Glass Ceiling and Human Rights in Sub-Saharan Africa: The Critical Challenge of Women's Rights,"


Whereas, you enthusiastically support Purchase College's alumni engaged in pursuit of careers in the areas of advocacy and human rights as well as the global initiatives of the college,

Senior Class Speaker and Ceremonial Brick and Mace

Senior Class Speaker

A Commencement tradition, the senior class speaker is chosen to reflect the graduating class experience and represents the very best of Purchase College. A panel of faculty and staff members review applications and choose the senior class speaker on how well they represent the ideals and values of Purchase College.

Ceremonial Brick

The Brick Holder ceremony is one of our fondest traditions. First given to a student at the 1998 freshman orientation program, this brick is now awarded to a graduating senior who has made an outstanding contribution to the quality of student life throughout their Purchase tenure. By “returning” the brick, the values of leadership, service, involvement, and positive change are gifted forward to the next class of graduates.

Ceremonial Mace

The mace, traditionally a staff made of metal or wood, has been used in ceremonial occasions since the 14th century by European universities as a symbol of university scholarship.

In 2003, President Thomas Schwarz asked faculty members Dennis FitzGerald and Eric Wildrick to create a ceremonial mace for Purchase College.

The head of the Purchase College ceremonial mace is a bronze and stainless steel form that represents the “The Flame of Knowledge.” The stainless steel core of the “flame” is surrounded by six elements, representing each of the six constituencies of the college: Students, Faculty, Staff, Alumni, Administration, and Community.

The flame form is attached to a shaft of locally sourced walnut, a wood that symbolizes growth and nourishment.
