

## ONE OF THE SEVEN PRINCIPLES OF ART

## Patterns are tools that help grab your attention.

A pattern in an artwork is created by repeating or echoing the visual elements (such as line, shape, color, form, texture) in a recurring arrangement.


PATTERNS HELP CREATE VISUAL RHYTHM IN AN ARTWORK. Sometimes patterns are regular, repeating, and geometric (like a checkerboard or a sidewalk made of bricks) and sometimes they are more irregular, natural, and organic (like leaves on a tree or shells on a beach). How an artist chooses to use a pattern can affect how you feel when you look at his or her work. For example, pattern can make you feel calm or excited. Patterns may be the entire focus of the art, a technique in the overall composition, or a decoration that is part of the larger work.

There are two basic types of pattern: MAN-MADE or NATURAL
Both can be:

## Regular or Irregular <br> Organic or Geometric <br> Structural or Decorative <br> Positive or Negative Repeating or Random
