

THE SEVEN PRINCIPLES OF ART

UNITY is about separate parts working together in a composition.
In an artwork, unity creates a sense of harmony and wholeness by using similar elements and placing them in a way that creates a feeling of "oneness."

VARIETY adds interest by using juxtaposition and contrasting elements within the composition.
When an artist places different visual elements next to one another, he/she is using variety: Straight lines next to curvy lines. Organic shapes among geometric shapes. Bright colors next to dull colors.

See how Unity and Variety are each illustrated in the two examples below.
