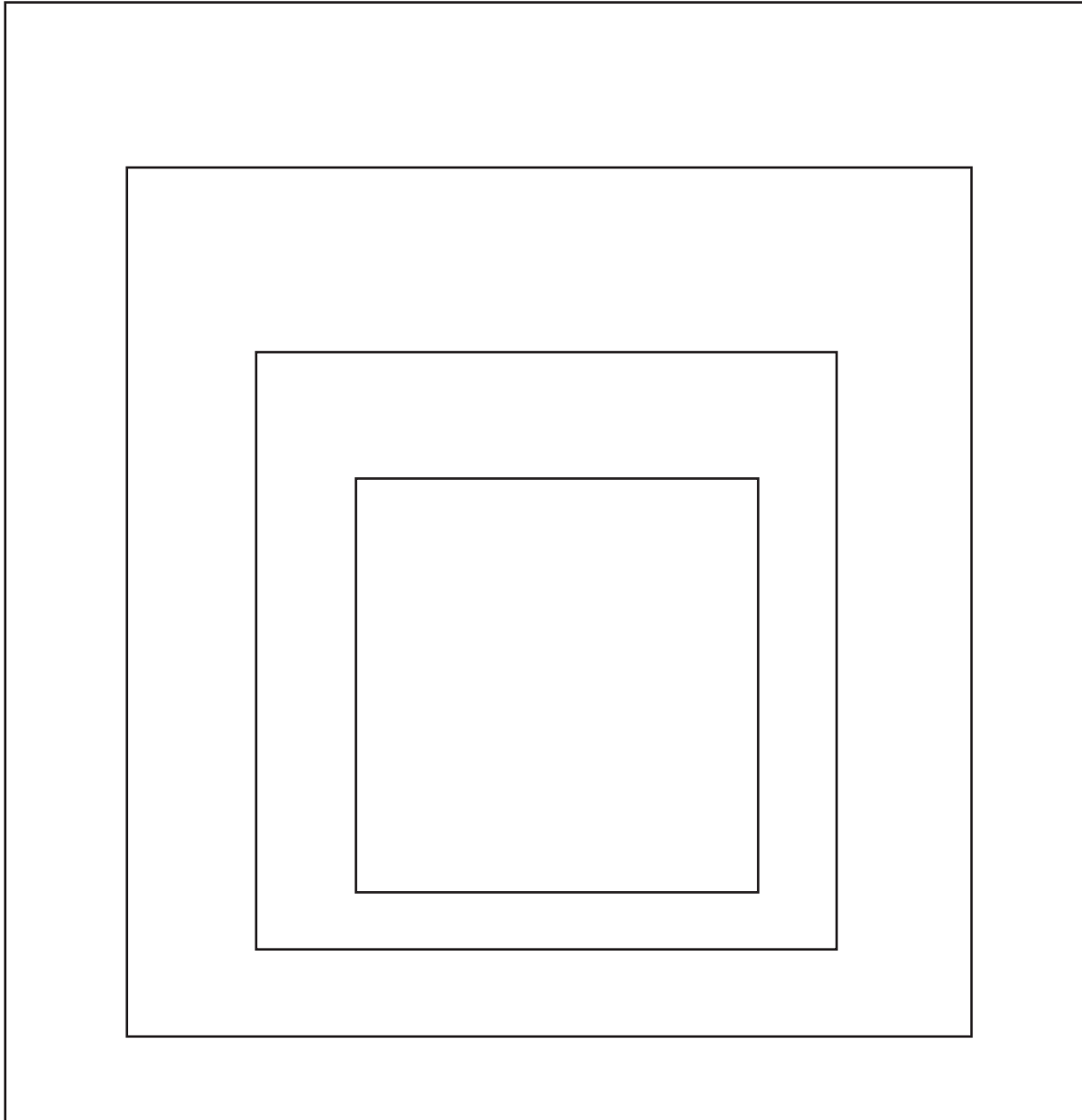
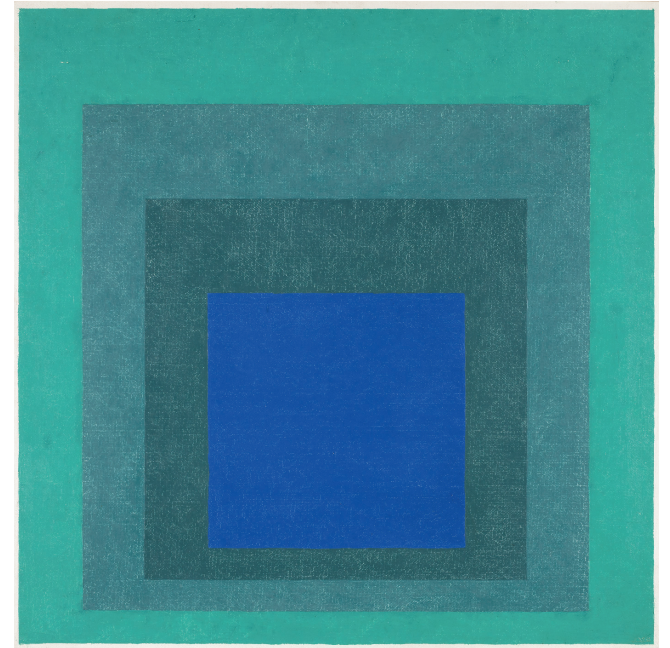


Fill the squares below with four different colors to explore how the colors interact.
