How do I take the survey?

An email invitation to participate in the survey will be sent from SUNY System Administration (survey@suny.edu) on Monday, March 6th.

Who will take this survey?

The Campus Climate Survey is designed for all students, faculty, and staff. There are two separate surveys - one for students and one for faculty and staff. Students 18 and older are eligible to take this survey. The survey is voluntary, and respondents will not be identified.

Why Should You Take the Time to Fill Out the Survey?

Your feedback is very important in helping us understand your Purchase experience.

- Ensures administration understands the full scope of sexual & interpersonal violence issues on campus as well as strengths and areas for improvement in communicating about resources and services.
- Provides an opportunity for collaborative work between students, faculty/staff and administration on this critical issue.
- Ensures administration understands your perspective (results will be viewed by senior administrators but only in aggregate).
- Helps campus community contribute to determining future steps and programming.
